## Editorial 2009

### Keine Krise im Modellautosport

Das Jahr 2009 dessen Wettbewerbsergebnisse Sie in diesem Heft nachlesen können, ist bereits Geschichte, was uns bleibt sind die Erinnerungen.

War es ein Krisenjahr? Die Wirtschaftskrise kratzte an vielen Fassaden von Unternehmen und ist auch jetzt noch nicht vollkommen vom Tisch. Eine Auswirkung auf unseren Modellsport hatte es nicht. Im Gegenteil: Gualtiero Picco (Weltrekord) und mir sind je zwei Superläufe von über 340 km/h in Australien geglückt und in allen anderen Klassen nahm die Leistungsdichte zu.

Die EM in Örebro in Schweden war von dem kleinen Team um Nils Björk sehr gut organisiert. Mein Kompliment und Dank dazu.

Die sechs Läufe zu dem GRAND SLAM Rennen wurden wieder zahlreich besucht, wobei es ja um Tickets zur WM nach Australien ging. Auch das Nikolausrennen in Kapfenhardt im Dezember wurde mit grosser Beteiligung und Begeisterung wahrgenommen.

Im gesamten hatten wir schöne, spannende Rennen auf allen Pisten in Europa.

Meine 1995 von Studenten durchgeführte Befragung der Zuschauer während der EM in Kapfenhardt, zum Zwecke der Mitgliedsfindung, hat folgende Fragen offengelegt:

1. Wo kann ich ein solches Automodell kaufen?
2. Wieviel kostet es?
3. Wo kann man Rennen fahren?
4. Was kann man gewinnen?

Auf verschiedenen GV interpretierte man das Ergebnis, dass man für die Jugend eine "einfache neue Klasse" mit einem 3,5ccm Motor schaffen müsse. Die Diskussion über die Regeln zog sich über mehrere Jahre jeweils auf den GV hin und nachdem diese Klasse mit seinen vielseitigen Regeln, noch zu der Mannschaftswertung auf EM aufgenommen wurde, waren erfahrene Meisterfahrer, die in dieser Klasse dominierten. Wirklich junge Einsteiger verloren schnell die Begeisterung. Aus heutiger Sicht war das ein Schuss der nach hinten losging. Bestrebungen einiger Mitgliedsländer eine neue Jugendklasse mit 2,1ccm Motoren zu schaffen, sollen bitte nur national bleiben.

Eine Erweiterung unseres FEMA Klassements lehne ich vehement ab. Ein abschreckendes Beispiel dafür sind die U.S.A. Bei Ihren "Nationals" (mit unserer EM zu vergleichen) gibt es über 12 Klassen mit jeweils lächerlichen drei Teilnehmern.

Für mich lautete das Ergebnis der damaligen Zuschauerumfrage, ein Modellauto anzubieten "ready to run". Eine der wichtigsten Marketingregeln heisst Engpassorientierung, ein Ausrichten auf die Grundbedürfnisse einer Sportart.

Der jetzige Vorteil der Wirtschaftskrise für unseren Sport ist, die enorm geschrumpfte Auftragslage bei den Modellmotorenherstellern. Auf meine Initiative hin baut Gualtiero Picco in seiner Firma jetzt eine Kleinserie seines "Weltrekord Modellautos". Geplant waren 10 bis 12 Stück, z.Z. während ich diesen Artikel schreibe liegt der Auftragsbestand bei über 24 Stück, ohne in den U.S.A. oder in Australien geworben zu haben.

Nach der Klasse 10ccm wird eine Serie von 5ccm Motoren und dazu 5ccm Modelle hergestellt. Dass uns dies neue Mitglieder, ganz gleich welcher Altersgruppe, bringen wird, davon bin ich überzeugt.

Auf der letzten GV haben wir mit Tonu Sepp ein neues Mitglied ins FEMA Präsidium gewählt. Ich begrüße diesen Entscheid sehr, da Tonu Sepp, sportlich sehr erfolgreich, persönlich seine ruhige, aber sehr effektive Mitarbeit eine Bereicherung darstellt. Ihm untersteht Public Relations, diesen Bereich leitet er schein seit Jahren als Administrator unseres Unternehmensportals [www.speedmodelcar.com](http://www.speedmodelcar.com) sehr erfolgreich.

Das Jahr 2010 wirft seine Schatten voraus. Zwei Grossereignisse, die EM in Karpfenhardt und die WM in Sydney werden wieder eine Demonstration unseres spannenden Hobbys sein und bestimmt zur Pflege alter und neuer Freundschaften beitragen.

Ihnen ALLEN wünsche ich gute Gesundheit für das neue Jahr und nützen Sie die Vorbereitungszeit um noch schneller höhere Geschwindigkeiten mit ihrem Modellauto zu erreichen.

## Editorial

### No Crisis in Model Car Sport

The results of the 2009 championship are already history and what you are now reading are memories of the season that has gone by.

Was it a critical year? The economic crisis touched many people and businesses and even now it is still with us. But did it affect our small group of model car racers? My answer is no; quite the opposite, in fact. Gualtiero Picco set a new World Record in the 10 cc and both he and I managed to have two super runs of over 340 km/h in Australia, where, in all classes the speeds were closer to the maximum for the class.

The European Championship in Örebro, Sweden, was well organised by a small team led by Nils Björk. My heartiest thanks go to him and his team for a job well done.

The six Grand Slam races, held at different tracks during the year were well supported by our members and mention should be made of the prizes of tickets to the 2010 World championship in Australia for the lucky winners. The St Nicholas races in Kapfenhardt in December were also well supported by the enthusiasts among us. All in all, we have had a good 2009 season in Europe without any accidents.

The face to face interviews held by students with the spectators during the 1995 EM Championship in Kapfenhardt resulted in potential new members asking the following questions:

1. Where can I get such a model car?
2. How much must I pay for it?
3. Where are races held?
4. What are the winners' prizes?

At various GV meetings we concluded that the result of this survey should be a new 3.5 cc Monza class; 3.5 cc motors being readily available in the model shops. Discussions about rules took place over several years and ended with many pages of new rules for this class. The youngsters, beginners, finally lost interest and, after analysing the results it was clear that only experienced people were the winners. This was a setback to us all.

Today, any efforts by members to organise a Young Model Group with 2.1 cc motors should be strictly on a national level. An expansion of the FEMA classes is not desirable and I am totally against it. The US is an example of an absurd situation where they have over 12 classes at their Nationals, the equivalent of our EM, and only 3 participants in some classes. The results from the 1995 survey tell me that it would be wise to offer interested people a "ready to run" model car. The conclusion must be to remove bottlenecks and encourage new members by addressing the basic needs and concerns of these members.

On my recommendations Gualtiero Picco is now producing a series of cars based on his World Record Model. He had planned to make about 12 cars but, as I write this, he has orders for 24; this without any promotion in the USA or Australia. He will next produce a series of 5 cc motors and, in due course, a 5 cc car. I am positive that this will attract new members, irrespective of age etc.

At the last General Assembly we elected Tonu Sepp as the FEMA Chairman. I welcome this very much. Tonu is a successful sportsman and has an amiable personality. He is also our Public Relations Officer, a job he has maintained over the years – see our website: [www.speedmodelcar.com](http://www.speedmodelcar.com) - an asset to our hobby.

2010 has two big events for us: the EM in Karpfenhardt, Germany, and the WM in Sydney, Australia. These will be demonstrations of our exciting hobby and, at the same time, a chance to renew old friendships and to establish new ones.

I wish you all very good health and success in 2010. Please use the time between now and the start of the racing season to prepare your cars in order to achieve even better results in the new racing season.

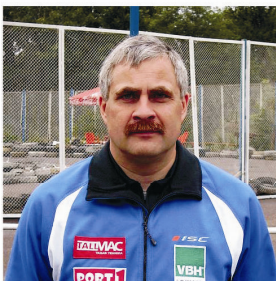

## **Protokoll der 58. Delegiertenversammlung der FEMA**

**in Örebro, Schweden am 30. Juli 2009**

### **1. Begrüssung durch den Präsidenten**

FEMA Präsident Paul-Otto Ströbel eröffnete die Delegiertenversammlung um 19.50 Uhr.

### **2. Anwesenheitsfeststellung**

Folgende Länder waren vertreten: Bulgarien, Deutschland, Estland, Frankreich, Grossbritannien, Italien, Norwegen, Polen, Schweden, Schweiz, Ukraine und Weissrussland. Gesamthaft 12 Länder, die Versammlung ist beschlussfähig.

### **3. Bestätigung der Tagesordnung**

Die Tagesordnung wurde einstimmig genehmigt.

### **4. Bestätigung des Protokolls der letzten GV von Stryi**

Bei Urs Bach (CH) war die Kennzeichnung gemacht, dass im Punkt 11 bereits abgestimmt war, dass Basel als Austragungsort EM+WM 2013 bestimmt war. Das wurde zur Kenntnis genommen. Die Versammlung bestätigt einstimmig das Protokoll der letzten DV.

### **5. Bericht des Präsidenten P.O.Ströbel zur abgelaufenen Rennsaison 2008/2009**

2 Hauptthemen waren der Schwerpunkt seines Berichtes:

- a) Neuwahl zum FEMA Präsidium mit neuer Arbeitsaufteilung;
- b) Finanzen.

Er dankte dem Präsidiumsmitglied V.Kruger (RUS) für seine geleisteten Verdienste und seinen Einsatz bezüglich der Organisation der WM+EM in Jaroslavl.

Der Posten Organisation im Präsidium wird umbenannt zum Posten für Öffentlichkeitsarbeit das heisst es muss eine bessere marketing gerechte Repräsentation der unsere Aktivitäten in der Öffentlichkeit erfolgen. Wichtig hierzu ist es, die richtige Person dafür zu finden.

Zum Punkt Finanzen erklärte der Präsident, dass er strikt gegen die Einführung einer Startgebühr sei, denn man könne den Teilnehmern nicht nach den teureren Reisekosten zu den Rennen auch noch Startgebühren zumuten.

Einnahmen zur Erhaltung von Pisten: dafür geben Kapfenhardt, Tallinn und Basel- durch die Verköstigung der Teilnehmer und Zuschauer ein gutes Beispiel.

Ein weiteres Thema seines Berichtes war die Klasse 5, in der der nächste Kabeltausch immer näher kommt. 2,1 mm Kabel ist die maximale Stärke für die Herstellung nach unserem System. Ab dann muss das Gewicht des Modells reduziert werden: z.B. 10 ccm jetzt 3130 gr, später 3030 gr.

Zum Schluss seines Berichtes wiederholte er die Einladung von unseren Modellautofahrern aus Australien, die 2010 zahlreiche Teilnehmer aus Europa zur WM erwarten (29.-31.10.2010).

Der Präsident schloss seinen Bericht mit dem Wunsch „Good Speed for all Competitors“ und viel Vergnügen und alles Gute für die EM- hier in Schweden.

## **6. Kassenbericht von P.Arlautzki**

Die DV wurde über die finanzielle Situation der FEMA informiert. Eine Jahresrechnung wurde den Delegierten verteilt. Wir haben zurzeit €12902.20 Aktiva in der FEMA. Alle Länder haben die Länderbeiträge und die Lizenzgebühren bezahlt.

## **7. Bericht des Kassenprüfers**

Ivar Thorpman und Leif Persson aus Schweden haben die Kasse geprüft. Sie fanden die Buchführung in Ordnung und es konnten keine Fehler und Unklarheiten festgestellt werden.

Der Kassenprüfungsbericht wurde einstimmig angenommen.

## **8. Rücktritte des Generalsekretärs, des Kassiers, des tech. Sekretärs und des Sekretärs für Organisation**

Die Entlastung des Präsidiums wurde einstimmig angenommen. Danach folgte der Rücktritt des Generalsekretärs, des Kassiers, des tech. Sekretärs und des Sekretärs für Organisation.

## **9. Wahlen**

**9.1.** Auf Vorschlag des Präsidenten P.O.Ströbel soll Lembit Vaher (Estland) weitere 2 Jahre als Generalsekretär arbeiten. Lembit Vaher wurde von den Delegierten einstimmig gewählt.

**9.2.** Auf Vorschlag des Präsidenten P.O.Ströbel soll Daniel Kiechl (Schweiz) weitere 2 Jahre als technischer Sekretär arbeiten. Daniel Kiechl wurde von den Delegierten einstimmig gewählt.

**9.3.** Auf Vorschlag des Präsidenten P.O.Ströbel soll Peter Arlautzki (Schweiz) weitere 2 Jahre als Kassier arbeiten. Peter Arlautzki wurde von den Delegierten einstimmig gewählt.

**9.4.** Als PR und Öffentlichkeit Sekretär schlägt Urs Bach (Schweiz) Tõnu Sepp aus Estland vor. Es gibt keinen weiteren Kandidaten für dieses neue Amt. Die Delegierten wählen Tõnu Sepp einstimmig als PR und Öffentlichkeit Sekretär neu ins Präsidium.

## **10. Vorschläge aus dem Präsidium**

**10.1.** Die Vorschläge über die Änderungen im Technischen Reglement über die Punkte 5.18.3, 5.9.2 und 6.1.5.1, die vom Vorstand ausgearbeitet wurden, sind nach kurzer Diskussionen bis 2013 vertragen worden.

**10.2.** Wie wird das Grand Slam 2010 gewertet werden?

Es wurde beschlossen, dass das Grand Slam 2010 wie im Jahre 2009 durch 3 Wettbewerbe im Norden Europas und 3 im Süden Europas ausgefahren wird. Aus diesen 6 Rennen werden die 4 besten Ergebnissen für den Grand Slam gewertet. Der letzte Wettbewerb zählt dabei doppelt (doppelte Punkte). Die EM zählt einfach (einfache Punkte).

## **11. Finanzvorschlag für das kommende Jahr**

P.O.Ströbel hat einen Finanzvorschlag für das Jahr 2010 gemacht: Länderbeitrag € 100.-, Fahrerbeitrag € 10.-. Es soll auch weiterhin ein EM-Zuschuss in der Höhe von € 1000.- an den Veranstalter der EM gezahlt werden. Der Vorschlag wurde einstimmig von den Delegierten angenommen.

## 12. Festlegen der Austragungsorte und der Veranstaltungstermine:

EM 2010: Der Vorschlag aus Deutschland, dass die EM 2010 in Kapfenhardt vom 30.Juli bis 1.August durchgeführt werden solle, wurde einstimmig angenommen.

WM 2010: Die nächste WM wird in Australien Sydney vom 29.-31.Oktober durchgeführt werden.

EM 2011: Estland hat schon den Vorschlag gemacht, dass die EM 2011 in Tallinn durchgeführt wird. Vorschlag wurde angenommen.

EM 2012: Für die Austragung der EM 2012 schlugen Polen und der Ukraine vor. Nach kurzer Diskussion wurde einstimmig beschlossen, dass EM 2012 in Polen durchgeführt wird.

EM+WM 2013: Wie unter Punkt 4 bereits diskutiert wurde, wird die EM+WM 2013 in der Schweiz durchgeführt werden. Dies wurde einstimmig angenommen.

**Minutes of the 58th FEMA General Meeting**  
**in Örebro, Sweden on 30 July 2009**

**1. Greetings by the President**

President of FEMA, Paul-Otto Ströbel opened the meeting at 19.50 hrs.

**2. Statement of the Meeting**

The following countries were present: Belarus, Bulgaria, Estonia, France, Germany, Great Britain, Italy, Norway, Poland, Sweden, Switzerland, and the Ukraine. In total 12 countries, which made the meeting quorum.

**3. Confirmation of the Agenda**

Confirmed with 100% of the votes.

**4. Confirmation of the Minutes of the last General Meeting in Stryi**

Urs Bach (CH) pointed out that in point 11 it had already been voted that the 2013 EC+WC would be held in Basel. It was taken into consideration. The delegates unanimously accepted the minutes of the last GM.

**5. Report of president P.O.Ströbel about the past racing season 2008/2009.**

His report focused on two main topics:

- a) Electing the new FEMA board with new work allocation
- b) Finances.

The president thanked V. Kriger (RUS), member of the presidency, for his good job and for his commitment to organizing the WC+EC in Jaroslavl.

The post of the secretary of the organization will be renamed the secretary of public relations meaning that this should ensure more publicity to our activities. It is important to find the right person for that post.

Concerning the finances the president stated clearly that he is strictly opposed to introducing starting fees, because the participants cannot be expected to cover both high travelling costs and entry fees at the same time.

Kapfenhardt, Tallinn, and Basel were mentioned as good examples of how to raise money for the maintenance of the tracks through catering for the participants and visitors.

The next topic of the report considered class 5 in which the time to make the next cable change is quickly approaching. 2.1 mm is the maximum possible diameter, which can be used to produce the cables with our technology. Up to then the weight of the cars should be reduced: for instance if a 10 cc weighs 3130 grams now, then later it should weigh 3030 grams.

The president ended his report passing on the invitation of Australian modelcar drivers who expect to have many participants from Europe at the 2010 WC on 29-31 October 2010.

The president closed his report wishing 'Good Speed for all Competitors' and lots of fun and good luck for the EC here in Sweden.

## **6. Cashier's report from P.Arlautzki**

The GM was informed of the current financial situation of FEMA. The cash statement of the past year was distributed to the delegates. At the moment the cash position is € 12,902.20. All countries have paid for the country and license fees.

## **7. Auditors report**

Ivar Thorpman and Leif Persson from Sweden audited the treasury. They found everything in order; the books were kept clearly and without any recognizable errors. Auditor's report was confirmed with 100% of the votes.

## **8. Relieve from presidency**

Secretary general, treasurer, technical secretary and secretary of the organization were relieved of their posts with 100% of the votes.

## **9. Elections**

**9.1.** President P.O.Ströbel proposed that Lembit Vaher (Estonia) should continue another 2 years as secretary general. It was confirmed with 100% of the votes.

**9.2.** President P.O.Ströbel proposed that Daniel Kiechl (Switzerland) should continue another 2 years as technical secretary. It was confirmed with 100% of the votes.

**9.3.** President P.O.Ströbel proposed that Peter Arlautzki (Switzerland) should continue another 2 years as treasurer. It was confirmed with 100% of the votes.

**9.4.** Urs Bach (Switzerland) proposed to nominate Tõnu Sepp (Estonia) for the post the secretary of public relations. No other candidates were nominated for that new post. The delegates unanimously elected Tõnu Sepp as the PR secretary for the next 2 years.

## **10. Proposals from the presidium for voting**

**10.1** The proposals on the amendments to the Technical Regulations on the points 5.18.3, 5.9.2, and 6.1.5.1, which were prepared by the Executive Board, have been postponed after a short discussion until 2013.

**10.2** How will the Grand Slam 2010 be scored?

It was unanimously decided that the Grand Slam 2010 would be held like in 2009 with 3 competitions in Northern Europe and 3 in Southern Europe. However, only 4 best points out of the 6 competitions will be taken into account. The final Grand Slam stage will score double points. The EC will score only the usual amount of points.

## **11. Financial proposals for the coming year**

P.O.Ströbel made a financial proposal for 2010: national contribution 100 euros, and driver's fee 10 euros. The organizer of the EC will continue receive a grant of 1,000 euros. The proposal was accepted by the delegates with 100% of the votes.

## **12. Proposals for the dates of EC and GP + GS competitions.**

EC 2010: the proposal from Germany on organizing the EC 2010 in Kapfenhardt from 30 July to 01 August was unanimously accepted by the delegates.

WC 2010: the next WC will be held in Australia in Sydney on 29-31 October.

EC 2011: Estonia has already proposed that the EC 2011 will be carried out in Tallinn. The proposal was accepted by the delegates.

EC 2012: Poland and the Ukraine both applied for organizing the EC in 2012. After short discussions it was unanimously decided that the EC 2012 would be carried out in Poland.

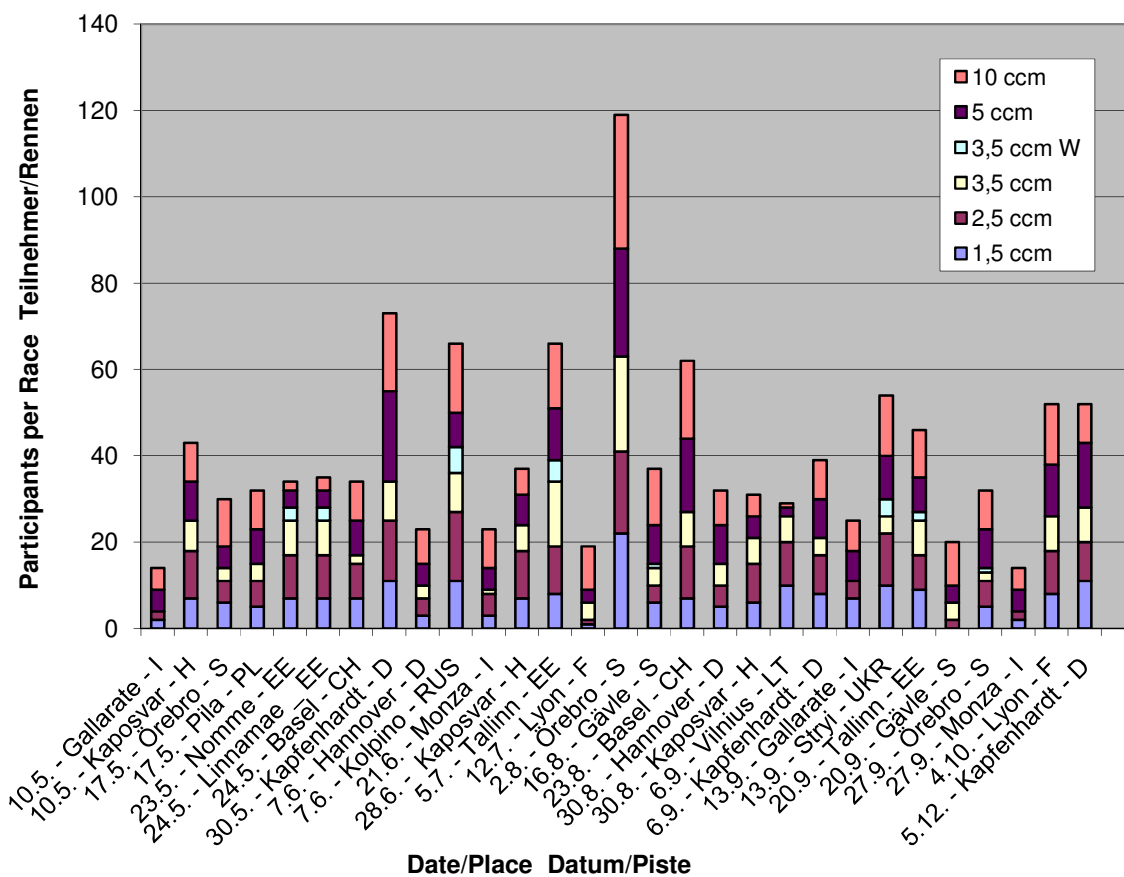
