FEMA Grand Slam rules and prizes 2019

Dear FEMA members

The 2019 racing season once again will have two main events. The European Championship in Pecs / Hungary and the traditional Grand Slam race series consisting of the following six designated races.

Venues

Rules

Out of the six designated races, the best four will count for the final ranking.

At the first five Grand Slam races the following points can be earned in each class.

First place	10 points
Second place	8 points
Third place	6 points
Fourth place	5 points
Fifth place	4 points
Sixth place	3 points
Seventh place	2 points
Eighth place	1 point

At the last Grand Slam race the following points can be earned in each class.

First place	20 points
Second place	16 points
Third place	12 points
Fourth place	10 points
Fifth place	8 points
Sixth place	6 points
Seventh place	4 points
Eighth place	2 points

All competitors of each GS race will be included automatically but only with one model car per class. Each of the six categories will be counted on its own. If two racers finish the Grand Slam with the same amount of points, the one with the better ranking at the European Championship or the driver with better ranking at the GS final stage will get the better place.

Grand Slam Awards

The prizes are for the last time sponsored by Paul-Otto Ströbel. Therefore, all FEMA members are requested to come forward with proposals, on how the future of the Grand Slam races should look like in the 2020-racing season.

The first prize in the final Grand Slam ranking in WMCR Class I / II / III / IV and V are flight tickets to a race in the USA in 2020. Second and third places are awarded with money prizes. Grand Slam Diplomas are awarded to the first five places.

FEMA Class III b will be counted in the same manner as the other classes, but not awarded with a flight ticket or money prizes. However Grand Slam Diplomas are also awarded to the first five places.

As the purpose of the first prize is to bring the speedmodelcar community from all around the world closer together and build friendships with our fellow racers in the USA and Australia, the first prize cannot be reimbursed.

If the winner of a flight ticket cannot or is not willing to travel to the race in the USA, the flight ticket has to be awarded to a racer with modelcar chosen by the prize winner.

If one person wins two Grand Slam flight tickets, the same rule applies. The second ticket cannot be reimbursed and has to be given to a speedmodelcar racer with own model who was active during the racing season in which the prize was awarded.
