The Tethered Race Car Association of Australia's 3.5 cc M Class is for open wheel cars with no suspension and spur gear drive that are powered by an un-piped 3.5 cc engine.

It is the most popular class in local race meetings, with virtually every club member owning and racing at least one.

The event run in conjunction with the World Championships is for both outright speed (where the fastest car wins) and a nominated speed competition, where a driver attempts to accurately predict the speed that their car will record, and the closest to their nominated is declared the winner.
